## 1 CERTIFICATION FEES

The certification fees are exclusive of all duties, taxes, levies including, VAT, registration taxes and other charges levied by any local, state, or other governmental authority, all of which shall be borne by the Organisation. The fees are normally expressed in Euro (€).

The Textile Exchange registration fees are expressed in US dollar but will be invoiced in EURO applying the conversion rate, using the currency calculator tools OANDA ([www.oanda.com](http://www.oanda.com)), at the respective issue date of the invoice plus 5%.

The number of days requested to conduct the onsite inspection is calculated on the basis of the following data:

- The type of activity and their relevance in terms of “environmental requirements” and “social aspects”;
- Level of “vertical integration of activities” which indicates the number of consequential processes managed within a single production unit. The higher is the level of vertical integration the more relevant is the risk associated to the factory and, consequently, the higher is the number of days needed to carry out a proper audit;
- Number of factories owned by the applicant organisation and their location;
- Number of non-certified subcontractors and their location.

### General Certification fees

1.b) Audit fees, including time for: travel, audit, preparation of the report	500 man/day
1.c) Laboratory tests fees	(according to the costs of analysis requested)
1.d) Issuance of Scope Certificate	700
1.e) Annual registration fees due to Global Standard GmbH, Textile Exchange	(according to the fees requested by GOTS or TE)

### Assessment of chemical products – GRS Certification

The following fees are referred to the assessment of chemical products used in the GRS processes. These fees have to be intended as additional to the “Assessment of documents fees” indicated in table 1.

Tab. 1/bis – Fees for assessment of chemical products

Type and number of chemical products	Fees
1. Chemical products for which a valid third party certificate of compliance to the MRSL of ZDHC and that allow the registration at level 1, 2 or 3 of ZDHC’s Gateway. Examples of recognised third party certifications are: GOTS; Bluesign; Eco Passport; etc.	No additional cost.
2. Chemical products which are not registered in ZDHC’s Gateway:	
a) Up to 25	No additional cost.
b) From 26 to 50 chemical products	10 Euro/product
c) From 51 to 100 chemical products	7 Euro/product
d) More than 100 chemical products	5 Euro/ product
